Returning to Fairfield I found a number of our young people repainting and

refurbishing their classroom. Ben and Roger were here finishing some extensive yard work around the building. Sitting down to ponder on some thoughts and notes I had jotted down a few days ago, I asked God to help me arrange those thoughts into a

sermon that would edify, encourage, and exhort the congregation to greater faith, and effectiveness.

The afternoon is passing by quickly and according to my self-imposed deadlines, I need to get a bulletin article done before I

leave. I need to send a copy of the order of worship to John, our worship leader for Sunday, and I need to prepare a devotional time for tomorrow evening. Tonight (Tuesday) there is a Bible study planned at the club house of the Apple's. Depending upon the time the Bible study finishes, I may drive to Vallejo to see how Gordon comes through his surgery.

These things are part of a day that God has allowed me and other people to serve Him and to give Him glory, honor, and praise.

The Pictorial Directory in the foyer has been updated with the pictures of those who had them done in September and October—now you can stop using pronouns and use actual names!

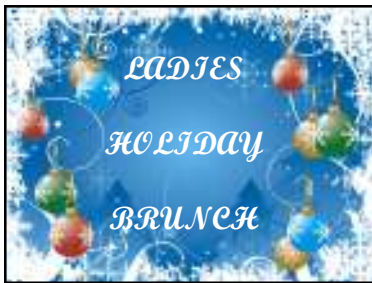

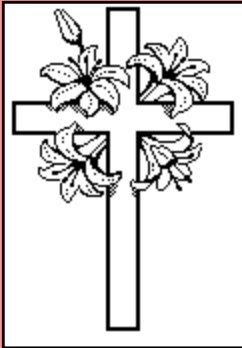
