## A PROPER VIEW OF LIFE

The following is taken, and edited from the book, *Surviving in an Angry World* by Charles F. Stanley: Does everything in your life go the way you want it to go? Have you ever told God the way He should do things? Have you found yourself praying for how you will be blessed if God works things for you?

Any time we're pursuing what we want, without regard for what God wants, or what others need, we are moving away from God and toward selfishness, conceit, and rebellion. Most people think that rebellion is about juvenile delinquents, or criminals, or people who are locked up in San Quentin. Rebellion is any word, deed, action, thought, or attitude that is in opposition to the commands, principles, and nature of God.

Angry people are generally rebellious people. They are agitated that they don't get their way. Frustration also characterizes rebellious people. Their frustration usually comes from a lack of attaining personal goals. Some rebellious people are envious and greedy because others

are doing better than they are doing. Rebellious people are more interested in doing what feels good to them rather doing what is right, and good, and pure, and holy. Eventually angry, rebellious people begin to withdraw themselves from any desire to serve God and to love others. Their actions are manifest by rejecting any authority, especially authority that is set in place by the Lord.



In every area of life, God has established a line of authority. The authority the Lord has set in place is what keeps families, churches, and countries running orderly. Believe it or not, we

humans crave authority. No home, team, or church can exist without it. Someone has to call the plays on a football team. Someone is given the ultimate authority in a family. Every church will have those whom God ordains to reprove, rebuke, and exhort others and to pastor the flock.

When we yield ourselves to doing God's will His way, we will ultimately receive joy and peace.
