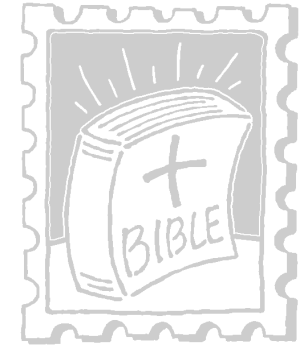


# Postcard

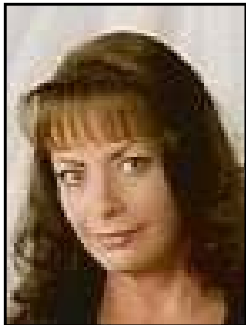
